

Please treat the facility with respect and help us keep it clean.

Treats

- Treats should not be crumbly or greasy.
- Please do not toss treats directly on the turf. Use a vessel (such as a Treat Hugger, Lotus Ball, Treat N Train, etc.) must be used to enclose the treat.
- A target may be used to place a treat.

Shoes

- Only CLEAN and DRY shoes may be worn on the turf.
- No spiked or metal spiked shoes may be worn. Rubber type cleats, such as Salomon's, are acceptable.

Food & Drinks

- No food or drinks, besides water, are permitted on the turf. Water must be in a screw top or fully closable water receptacle.
- Please do not place food or drinks on the half wall, there is a high chance it may get knocked onto the turf.

Equipment

- Only approved chairs (Folding Chairs with Flat Feet) may be used on the turf.
- Do not drag equipment on the turf, it is likely the turf will rip. Please ask for assistance if you can't move a piece of equipment on your own.

Please treat the facility with respect and help us keep it clean.

Accidents

- Because of the extensive cleaning needed after an accident to clean and sanitize the turf, a \$35 Turf Clean Up fee will be charged for Urine, Solid Poop or Vomit. A \$50 Turf Clean Up fee will be charged for Diarrhea.
- You must immediately report any turf accidents to an OTR instructor.
- There are clean up supplies ringside for accidents. Please follow the clean up protocol detailed in the turf clean up kit exactly.
- Dogs that have a history of soiling on the turf will be required to wear a belly band or panties to train on the turf. You will be responsible to supply this to continue training.

Class Walkthroughs

- OTR recommends that students bring a crate for class. If you prefer to tie your dog inside the ring during class walkthroughs, a mat is required to be underneath the dog. Students can provide their own mat, or there are many towels available for use.

Females in Season

- Females in season are required to wear panties within the four walls of the facility, there are no exceptions.

Failure to follow these rules may result in loss of privileges to the gym. OTR reserves the right to refuse access to any individual seen not cleaning up after their dogs, exhibiting poor sportsmanship, or being abusive to their dogs(s).
